

Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 2nd semester of the 2021/2022 academic year

Department: Genetics , Cell- and Immunobiology

Faculty: EM Immunology AOKGEN737_1A

Our feedback on general comments by the students: The feedback results for Immunology subject are equal, or in case of four questions slightly significantly lower than the faculty average.

A total of 253 students registered for Immunology AOKGEN737_1A, the number of students, who filled the OMHV evaluations prior to registration for the exams is 105 (41,5% of the registered students).

Taking some examples for the number of students attending the lectures were the next:

2022.02.21: 12 persons

2022.02.28: 15 persons

2022.03.07: 13 persons

In the other lectures the number of the students were more or less the same.

Taken together, as approx. 95 % of the registered students, and approx. 85 % of the students filled the evaluation sheet haven't attended the lectures, the result of the survey hardly reflects the real situation.

Actually the **average of on the spot (realtime after the lecture) evaluations of the lectures (K04, K05)**, varied between: **4.58-5 compared to the result (3.99/4.05) of the general OMHV survey.**

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

- *„The lectures were too long and too arduous to take notes of, let alone be able to listen to.”*. Answer: In the middle of the lecture we hold 5 minutes break. We are going to continue the recordings of the lectures in the future, as we have experienced this helps a lot to study properly
- *„In lecture halls, the voice of the professor sometimes is too small for the student to follow the lecture. If we want to listen again to a certain point in lecture, the best course of action is to use the voice recording of the lecture. Would it be possible for the professors to speak up louder or use a higher volume on the microphone so that we can follow the lecture?”* Answer: We have indicated to the Dean's office the need for the technical modernization of NET's large lecture halls so that the students would have a better audiovisual experience during the lectures. We are going to

continue the recordings and uploading the voice completed version of the live lectures in the future, as we have experienced this helps a lot to study properly.

- *„Sometimes the lectures felt quite disorganized and one walked away from it having no idea what was important from amongst all the details. It would be HIGHLY useful to have a one-slide summary at the end of each lecture, indicating the main message and take-aways of that hour and a half. Sometimes, with all the details, it was hard to decipher how much is expected of us to know for our exam and for our careers as general medicine doctors.”*. Answer: It's unfortunate that you feel that way. All the lectures are available in a voice completed version, animations follow the speed of live lecture voice. We are going to continue the recordings of the lectures in the future, as we have experienced this helps a lot to study properly. Moreover we provided online zoom consultations on each weeks of the exam period. We provided approx. 180 very basic pop-in questions with correct answers to help study the principles of immunology.
